





This activity helped them to explore their creative side, through this activity they learnt about the topic in a creative and fun way.

They claimed that they learned something new and were looking forward to the next class.














SCHOOL BAGS AND STATIONERY DISTRIBUTION DRIVE (1st February 2022)

Mahipalpur for students.



















Women's Day 8th March, 2022



DRISHTI PROJECT ACTIVITY CLASS


9th April ,2022

On April 9th, 2022, volunteers from our NGO Hamari Pahchan led fun activity learning classes for children in Coolie Camp as part of the Drishti Project. There was no set age range for the activities, but the children ranging from 10 to 16 years old were present and the students were made to fall in a straight line.

Firstly, we taught the students how to introduce themselves with their basic information like Name, Age, Grade, How many siblings and their Likes and Dislikes.

For example My name is Sonu, I am 6 years old, I study in 1st standard, I have 2 siblings and I love having chat foods. All students turnwise introduced themselves to their fellow friends with great enthusiasm.

Secondly, Our Team taught various body parts of a Human Body and the right way of pronunciation of words with an example. The body parts of Human Organs and sentence forming. The words like Ears, Nose, Tongue, Skin, Fingers, Stomach and Hair were taught using the Printout of it in an A4 Sheet. The sentences like I have Stomach Ache, I have 20 Fingers, I have 2 eyes and the Words like Ache and difficult such were explained to the students as well. The students at Coolie Camp looked very curious and eager to know the body parts and the right way to pronounce it.

ON APRIL 30TH, 2022 AROUND 5 VOLUNTEERS FROM HAMARI PAHCHAN NGO VISITED THE COOLIE CAMP AND LED THE INTERACTIVE AND LEARNING CHESS SESSION WITH YUVIKA SEHGAL FOR CHILDREN IN COOLIE CAMP. THERE WAS NO SET AGE RANGE FOR THE ACTIVITIES, BUT THE CHILDREN RANGING FROM 8 TO 16 YEARS OLD WERE PRESENT AND THE STUDENTS WERE MADE TO SIT IN A STRAIGHT LINE. THE VOLUNTEERS REACHED COOLIE CAMP AND STARTED MOBILIZING CHILDREN. THEY RECEIVED MISS


YUVIKA SEHGAL ALONG WITH HER FAMILY FROM THE FRONT GATE OF THE CAMP. ALL THE ARRANGEMENTS WERE MADE BY THE VOLUNTEERS WHICH INCLUDED HANGING POSTERS, MOBILISING CHILDREN, ETC. MISS YUVIKA ALSO BOUGHT HER EQUIPMENT LIKE A CHESSBOARD AND A CHESS CLOCK AND THEY WERE ALSO ARRANGED ON TIME.

THE SESSION STARTED WITH ONE OF THE VOLUNTEERS INTRODUCING YUVIKA TO STUDENTS AND THE STUDENTS SEEMED EAGER AND ENTHUSIASTIC ABOUT THE SESSION. YUVIKA STARTED WITH THE INTRODUCTION TO CHILDREN AND THEN TOLD THE BENEFITS OF CHESS IN DAILY LIFE. THEN, SHE MOVED ON TO A BASIC INTRODUCTION OF THE CHESS PIECES AND HOW THEY MOVE. THE SESSION ALSO INCLUDED MANY RESPONSES FROM CHILDREN.

THE SESSION PROCEEDED WITH THE HAMARI PAHCHAN NGO FOUNDER MR. TARUN MATHUR VISITING THE CAMP. HE INTERACTED WITH THE CHILDREN AND YUVIKA AND THEN, HE PRESENTED A GIFT FROM AN NGO TO YUVIKA. YUVIKA PRESENTED A BOOK TO HIM. YUVIKA WAS PRAISED FOR HER CHESS SKILLS AND CONFIDENCE BY HIM. IN THE END, TWO CHESS BOARDS WERE PROVIDED TO THE CAMP CHILDREN FOR THEIR OWN USE. THE SESSION FINALLY ENDED WITH A GROUP PHOTOGRAPH OF MR TARUN MATHUR, YUVIKA, HER FAMILY AND VOLUNTEERS.



IN THE CHESS SESSION, THE CHILDREN LEARNT THE BASICS OF CHESS. THIS SESSION PROVIDED AN OPPORTUNITY FOR THE CHILDREN TO LEARN SOMETHING NEW AND TO TEACH THEM THE BENEFITS OF PLAYING CHESS IN REAL LIFE. WHEN THE EVENT WAS OVER, THE KIDS WERE EAGER TO KNOW ABOUT THE NEXT SUCH SESSION.



ALL PAINTING IN COLLABORATION WITH AYKA FOUNDATION

6th and 21st May 2022

ON MAY 6TH, 2022 AROUND 7 VOLUNTEERS FROM HAMARI PAHCHAN NGO VISITED THE VASANT VIHAR FOR WALL PAINTING. IT WAS DONE IN COLLABORATION WITH THE AYKA GLOBAL FOUNDATION, PARISA FROM THE AYKA FOUNDATION ALSO ACCOMPANIED THE VOLUNTEERS. THE VOLUNTEERS CARRIED PAINT, BRUSHES AND NGO BANNER WITH THEM

THEY STARTED PAINTING THE WALL WITH WHITE COLOUR. PEOPLE PASSING BY WERE CURIOUS ABOUT THE WHOLE PROCESS. ONE OF THEM EVEN STOPPED AND ASKED TO VOLUNTEER. 

EVEN TWO CHILDREN JOINED THE VOLUNTEERS AND DREW THEIR HANDS ON THE WALL AND LATER FILLED THEM WITH COLOUR. THE SESSION CONCLUDED WITH AN INFORMAL PHOTO SESSION.

ON 21ST MAY, 2022, THE PAINTING WAS RESUMED WITH FOUR VOLUNTEERS FROM HAMARI PAHCHAN, AND THREE FROM THE AYKA FOUNDATION. ON THIS DAY THE WALL PAINTING WAS COMPLETED WITH, EXTENSION OF THE HAND PAINTINGS, SOCIAL MESSAGE, AND AYKA LOGO ON THE WALL. AT LAST VARNISH WAS SPRAYED ON THE WALL IN ORDER TO KEEP THE PAINT SUSTAINED.

THE PAINTING PROCESS WAS, BOTH ENJOYABLE AND INTERACTING, AROUND 10-12 BYPASSERS CAME TO INTERACT WITH US WHICH INCLUDED, A GROUP OF A MAN AND WOMEN WHO ALREADY KNEW ABOUT OUR NGO, PUT ON US SOME WORDS OF PRAISE AND EVEN INSISTED TO TAKE A PHOTOGRAPHS WITH THE WHOLE TEAM, AFTER THAT A MOTHER AND A CHILD STOPPED BY TO INQUIRE ABOUT THE WORK OF OUR NGO, LASTLY, THE LOCAL KIDS CAME IN AWE OF THE COLOURS AND EVEN PAINTED THEIR HANDS ON THE WALL.

THE SESSION PROCEEDED WITH QUESTIONS FROM WOMEN AND THEIR DIVERSE EXPERIENCES WERE ALSO DISCUSSED.

THE DISCUSSION INCLUDED WOMEN OF ALL AGES. THE SESSION ENDED WIT TWO PACKETS OF SANITARY PADS GIVEN TO EACH WOMAN ATTENDING THE SESSION.

THEY ALSO TALKED ABOUT THEIR EXPERIENCE REGARDING THE SESSION ALSO SHOWED INTEREST IN MORE SUCH SESSIONS IN FUTURE,



OVERALL SESSION WAS INFORMATIVE AND USEFUL FOR THE WOMEN.

IT BENEFITED THEM IN TERMS OF KNOWLEDGE AND SANITARY PADS ALSO. THE SESSION ALSO GAVE THEM AN OPPORTUNITY AND PLATFORM TO DISCUSS THE PROBLEM FACING EACH OTHER AS WELL AS WITH MS MITUSHI. WOMEN WERE KEEN ON ATTENDING MORE SUCH SESSIONS.

SURVEY FOR THE LEGAL AID AND AWARENESS CAMP

8th June - 11th June 2022

THE AIM OF THE SURVEY WAS TO GET A BRIEF ABOUT THE LEGAL ISSUES AND THE LEGAL AID THAT THE PEOPLE ARE IN NEED OF WHICH SHALL HELP US IN SHAPING THE WHOLE PURPOSE OF OUR LEGAL AWARENESS CAMP. BEFORE COMMENCING WITH THE SURVEY FROM HOUSE TO HOUSE, THE DUE PERMISSION OF THE VILLAGE PRADHAN WAS TAKEN INTO CONSIDERATION. THREE LEGAL INTERNS CONDUCTED THE STUDY ALONG WITH THE VOLUNTEERS OF HAMRI PAHCHAN NGO.

THE TEAM COULD REACH APPROXIMATELY 50 HOUSES IN THE COLLIE CAMP, VASANT VIHAR, AND GET MORE THAN 20 LEGAL ISSUES REGISTERED WITH HAMARI PACHCHAN.





14th JUNE 2022





GREEN DREAM





WE WERE ABLE TO GATHER 20 GIRLS FOR THE EVENT IN HALF AN HOUR AS VOLUNTEERS. MANYA, A VOLUNTEER AT OUR NGO, ORGANISED THE EVENT. SHE HAD THE IDEA TO TEACH CHILDREN ABOUT THE ENVIRONMENT. MANYA USED A VARIETY OF TECHNIQUES TO HELP CHILDREN TO ENCOURAGE CREATIVITY IN STUDENTS THROUGH EASY-TO-DO ACTIVITIES WHICH INCLUDED UNDERSTANDING THE PROCESS OF MAKING DECORATIVE ITEMS FOR THEIR HOME USING ICE CREAM STICKS. ACTIVITY WITH THEM





LEGAL AID AWARENESS CAMP


22nd June - 25th June 2022

The aim of the survey was to get a brief about the legal issues and the legal aid that the people are in need of which shall help us in shaping the whole purpose of our Legal awareness camp. Two legal interns of Hamari Pahchan NGO conducted the study for the legal aid camp. Both the interns could reach approximately 50-60 houses and conducted the survey at Bhanwar Singh Camp, Vasant Vihar, and got around 15 legal issues registered with Hamari Pachchan.





The purpose of the survey was to successfully achieve this to give us an outline for our awareness camp, and the mobilisation for the legal camp on Saturday, 25 June 2022.





The day had been thoroughly used. The children were happy and stuffed to the brim. Additionally, it was a very humbling experience for our volunteers. Children were inspired by the meal to make lifestyle changes so they could always have it when they desired it.



25th June, 2022

A very joyful event, a day full of fun activities was conducted by our organisation on 25th June 2022 where a group of volunteers from the U.S.A visited Coolie Camp, Vasant Vihar and spent some quality time with the children of coolie camp. The purpose of conducting this event was to make the kids able to interact with people from around the world. The volunteers reached the venue at 4:30 PM and received a warm welcome by the children of the Coolie Camp.

The kids had prepared a very beautiful welcome chart with their hand impressions on the chart as a border for the volunteers. Then the event proceeded with kids distributing their greetings cards they made for the volunteers. In the cards the kids had mentioned their future dreams as to what they want when they grow up or what they want to become in future.

One by one they gave their greeting cards to the volunteers. The volunteers seemed very happy to see future plans of the kids of the slum. After this the kids and the volunteers played dumb charades where one of the kids would tell one of the volunteers their future occupation and then that volunteer would enact the same and the other volunteers would have to guess it.

The game was full of laughter and enthusiasm. Everyone enjoyed it alot seemed to have a lot of fun. Some of the kids also presented dance performances, volunteers were stunned by the performances and were enjoying it very much and they even participated in between. Later all the volunteers one by one interacted with kids of the slum and introduced themselves and told the kids about what they want to become in future

Kids also made a drawing of "What's in my heart" in which they had drawn a heart and inside it they drew the things they like and then gave them to each one of the volunteers. Then our organisation gave the presents we prepared for the volunteers and the co-ordinator which contained handcrafted goodies by the underprivileged ladies.

And then the final activity of the event was conducted where the plant saplings were planted by the kids and the volunteers in pairs, each pair planted one plant sapling. And then the session was concluded with a group photograph and refreshment distribution.



AWARENESS SESSION ABOUT MENSTRUATION WITH SUKHAD KITS DISTRIBUTION





She discussed different new and eco-accommodating techniques for managing period. The session was then concluded by dispersing sukhad kits to oppressed women.








The team from Hamari Pahchan was successfully able to achieve their objective and could mobilise points for the legal camp to be organised on 25th & 29th June 2022.








CONCLUSION



MS. DEEPIKA SURI (IPS MP

13th JULY 2022

ON 13TH JULY AROUND 3 VOLUNTEERS FROM HAMARI PAHCHAN NGO VISITED BHANWARSINGH CAMP, VASANT VIHAR FOR AN INTERACTIVE CAREER COUNSELLING SESSION WITH MS. DEEPIKA SURI IPS MPS CADRE. THE MAIN AIM OF THE EVENT WAS TO PROVIDE KNOWLEDGE ABOUT THE UPSC EXAMINATIONS AND CAREERS IN THE FIELD. THE EVENT STARTED WITH INTRODUCING THEMSELVES TO MS. DEEPIKA SURI. THE KIDS WERE IN THE 11TH AND 12TH GRADES, SO THEY WERE ABOUT 17 AND 18 YEARS OLD. MOVING ON WITH THE EVENT, THE KIDS WERE ASTOUNDED TO DISCOVER SO MANY TOPICS THAT NOT MANY DISADVANTAGED KIDS ARE AWARE OF. FOLLOWING THE INTRODUCTION, MA'AM SPOKE TO THE KIDS ABOUT HER LIFE'S JOURNEY, THE CHALLENGES SHE FACED, AND HOW SHE OVERCAME THEM, ENCOURAGING THE KIDS TO NEVER BE FRIGHTENED OF FAILURE. MS. DEEPIKA ALSO ADDRESSED THE SOCIETAL PRESSURE ON MEN FOR HAVING A FINANCIALLY STABLE JOB AND INSPIRED THE GIRLS TO BECOME FINANCIALLY INDEPENDENT BY CHOOSING THE RIGHT CAREER FOR THEMSELVES. AS 2-3 CHILDREN WERE ALSO PREPARING FOR THEIR UPSC EXAMINATION, SHE ALSO PROVIDED GUIDANCE ON HOW TO PASS IT. THE KIDS ALSO ASKED ABOUT A LOT OF IMPORTANT ISSUES, SUCH AS HOW MUCH TIME ONE SHOULD DEVOTE TO PASSING THE TEST IF THEY FAIL IT ON THEIR FIRST TRY, AND HOW TO HANDLE SCAMS WHERE PEOPLE WHO HAVE ALREADY PASSED THE TEST ARE GIVEN FALSE GUARANTEES AND ARE ASKED FOR BRIBES IN RETURN.





VIRTUAL SESSION ON SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT BY EVA 16th JULY

ON 16 TH JULY, 3 VOLUNTEERS FROM HAMARI PAHCHAN NGO VISITED BHANWARSINGH CAMP, VASANT VIHAR FOR AN INTERACTIVE VIRTUAL SESSION ON SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT WITH EVA. THE MAIN AIM OF THE EVENT WAS TO SPREAD KNOWLEDGE ABOUT SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT AND HOW WOMEN CAN HELP IN PROVIDING AID FOR THE CAUSE. THE EVENT STARTED AT 3:00 PM, EVA INTRODUCED HERSELF AND SET UP AN INTERACTIVE GAME, DURING WHICH SHE QUESTIONED ALL THE LADIES IN ATTENDANCE ABOUT ANY SUSTAINABLE TRADITIONS THEY HAD ACQUIRED FROM THEIR ANCESTORS. EVA EDUCATED THE WOMEN ON HOW OUR PLANET IS BEING AFFECTED BY THE CHANGING CLIMATIC CONDITIONS. SHE THEN EXPLAINED TO EVERYONE HOW TINY PROBLEMS AT HOME CAN HAVE A BIG IMPACT ON THE ENVIRONMENT AND HOW TO AVOID THAT.

EVERYONE WAS VERY CURIOUS TO KNOW ABOUT THE TOPIC AND WAS READY TO HELP IN WHATEVER WAY THEY COULD, TOPICS LIKE FOOD WASTAGE AND SINGLE-USE PLASTIC WERE DISCUSSED. SOME WOMEN WERE ALREADY AWARE OF TWO OR THREE ENVIRONMENTALLY GOOD METHODS FOR REDUCING FOOD WASTE AT HOME, SUCH AS BURYING FRUIT AND VEGETABLE WASTES IN THE GROUND, WHICH BENEFITS THE ENVIRONMENT IN NUMEROUS WAYS. SOME ALSO MENTIONED REUSING LEFTOVER WATER FROM WATER BOTTLES TO CLEAN THE HOUSE. EVA ALSO INFORMED OTHER WAYS IN WHICH THEY CAN HELP THE ENVIRONMENT SUCH AS STORING FOOD APPROPRIATELY, GROWING MORE PLANTS, RECYCLING WASTE TO CONSERVE NATURAL RESOURCES, AND USING PAPER WHEN NEEDED. AT THE END OF THE MEETING, WE DISTRIBUTED REFRESHMENTS TO EVERYONE AND THEY WERE THRILLED.





SESSION ON SCIENCE EXPERIMENTS BY ISHAN 16th JULY

ON 23RD JULY 2022, 4 VOLUNTEERS FROM HAMARI PEHCHAN NGO VISITED BHANWAR SINGH CAMP LOCATED IN VASANT VIHAR TO ORGANISE AND TAKE PART IN AN INTERACTIVE SESSION CONSISTING OF VARIOUS SCIENTIFIC EXPERIMENT DEMONSTRATIONS BY ISHAN. THE MAIN AIM OF THE SESSION WA TO ASSOCIATE THE SUBJECT WITH FUN PRACTICAL IMPLEMENTATIONS FOR TH COMMUNITY CHILDREN. THE EVENT STARTED AT 12:30 WITH ISHAN INTRODUCING HIMSELF AND INTERACTING WITH THE CHILDREN GATHERED AT THE CAMP AND ASKING A FEW SIMPLE QUESTIONS ABOUT THE SUBJECT, WHICH THE CHILDREN WERE EAGER TO ANSWER. HE THEN FURTHER TALKED ABOUT TH TOPIC OF LIGHT. ISHAN WAS ABLE TO FOCUS THE ATTENTION OF THE ROOM OF THE TOPIC AND MAINTAIN AN ATMOSPHERE OF GENUINE CURIOSITY. HE GAVE A EXAMPLE OF THE APPEARANCE OF OBJECTS SUBMERGED UNDER THE WATER AN THEN PERFORMED AN EXPERIMENT ON THE TOPIC OF REFRACTION. WHILE PERFORMING THE EXPERIMENT HE DICTATED THE CONCEPT TO THE CHILDREN THE KIDS WERE AWESTRUCK BY THE EXPERIMENT AND WERE DELIGHTED TO SE THE CONCEPT OF REFRACTION IN A PRACTICAL MANNER.





ISHAN THEN INTRODUCED THE TOPIC OF COMBUSTION AND OXYGEN TO THE CHILDREN, HE WAS ABLE TO DICTATE THE CONCEPT IN A SIMPLE AND CONCISE MANNER SO THAT THE CHILDREN WERE INTERESTED IN IT. AFTER HE EXPLAINED THE CONCEPT HE PERFORMED AN EXPERIMENT INVOLVING A CANDLE, GLASS AND WATER. THE EXPERIMENT DEMONSTRATED HOW ATMOSPHERIC PRESSURE CHANGES WITH COMBUSTION, THIS INTERESTING EXPERIMENT GOT CHILDREN IN AN INQUISITIVE MOOD AND THEY ASKED QUESTIONS REGARDING THE EXPERIMENT WHICH ISHAN EASILY EXPLAINED TO THEM.

NOW IT WAS HIS TURN TO ASK QUESTIONS RELATED TO SCIENCE TO THE CHILDREN PRESENT AT THE CAMP, THOSE WHO CORRECTLY ANSWERED WERE REWARDED WITH TREATS SUCH AS CHOCOLATES AND CHIPS. THIS CONCLUDED THE SESSION ON SCIENTIFIC EXPERIMENTS AND THEN CHIPS WERE DEMONSTRATED BY THE VOLUNTEERS TO THE KIDS WHO ATTENDED THE SESSION. CHILDREN WERE OVERJOYED BY THE EXPERIENCE AND THE TREATS AND RETURNED HOME WITH A SMILE ON THEIR FACES AND KNOWLEDGE IN THEIR MINDS.





ON 23RD JULY, 4 VOLUNTEERS FROM HAMARI PAHCHAN NGO VISITED BHANWARSINGH CAMP, VASANT VIHAR FOR AN INTERACTIVE SESSION ON MENSTRUAL HYGIENE WITH ISHA. THE EVENT'S MAIN AIM WAS TO SPREAD KNOWLEDGE ABOUT MENSTRUAL HYGIENE AND HELP WOMEN KNOW MORE ABOUT THEIR BODIES. THE EVENT STARTED AT 1:00 PM, ISHA WAS WELL KNOWN AMONGST THE LADIES FOR CARRYING OUT PREVIOUS DRIVES THERE.

THE WOMEN HAD NUMEROUS INQUIRIES ON MENSTRUAL HYGIENE THROUGHOUT THE SESSION. ISHA EDUCATED ALL THE WOMEN ON IMPORTANT TOPICS RELATING TO MENSTRUAL HYGIENE SUCH AS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN DIFFERENT BLOOD COLOURS, WHAT CAN A PERSON EAT IN SUCH A TIME, HOW CAN THEY REDUCE PAIN DURING PERIODS, AND OTHER TOPICS LIKE PCOS AND PMS. MANY LADIES APPEARED TO ALREADY BE FAMILIAR WITH SOME OF THE BASICS OF THE SUBJECT.






RAKHI MAKING COMPETITON

MENSTRUATION SESSION CONDUCTED BY MS. PRIYAL




ON 13 AUGUST 2022, FOUR VOLUNTEERS FROM HAMARI PEHCHAN NGO VISITED BHAWAR SINGH CAMP FOR AN INFORMATIVE SESSION ON MENSTRUATION IMPARTED BY MS. PRIYAL. IT WAS A VIRTUAL SESSION. THE OBJECTIVE OF THIS SESSION WAS TO SPREAD INFORMATION ABOUT IRON DEFICIENCY IN WOMEN DUE TO MENSTRUATION AMONG UNDERPRIVILEGED WOMEN.

MS. PRIYAL COVERED THE FOLLOWING TOPICS - MEANING OF ANAEMIA, SYMPTOMS AND CAUSES OF IT, THE DIET INTAKE TO CURB ANAEMIA, PRECAUTIONS AND CURES OF THE DISEASE.

DURING THE SESSION, MS. PRIYAL INTERACTED WITH THE WOMEN AND ASKED THEM WHETHER THEY ARE AWARE OF THE DISEASE "ANAEMIA" OR NOT? FURTHER, SHE EXPLAINED WHAT IRON DEFICIENCY IN WOMEN WAS AND HOW IT IS CAUSED, DISCUSSING THE SYMPTOMS SEEN IN WOMEN AND WHETHER THEY HAD EXPERIENCED ANY OF THOSE BEFORE. ALL OF THEM SHARED SOME SIMILAR EXPERIENCES RELATED TO THE SYMPTOMS. THE WOMEN WERE CURIOUS ABOUT THE DIET INTAKE AND ASKED MS. PRIYAL ABOUT THE SAME. SHE ANSWERED THEM. SHE ALSO ADVISED THEM TO TAKE IRON SUPPLEMENTS.

MOREOVER, MS. PRIYAL SUGGESTED THE WOMEN TO TAKE PROPER DIET OR EVEN VISIT A DOCTOR IF THE PROBLEM PERSISTS.





SANITARY DRIVE


17th SEPTEMBER 2022

ON 17TH SEPTEMBER 2022, OUR NGO - HAMARI PAHCHAN CONDUCTED A DRIVE TO DISTRIBUTE SOME OF THE ESSENTIALS TO THE NEEDY IN HARIJAN SLUMS NEAR MAHIPALPUR.

THIS DRIVE WAS CONDUCTED IN ORDER TO BETTER THE SANITARY WELL BEING OF THE PEOPLE LIVING IN THE SLUMS AND THEIR CHILDREN. IN THIS DRIVE KEEPING IN MIND THE WEATHER, SOME UMBRELLAS WITH TOWELS AND DIAPERS WERE DISTRIBUTED. TO PREVENT DISEASES AND STRENGTHEN THE IMMUNITY, GLUCON - D AND SACHETS OF ORS WERE HANDED OUT.

WE ALSO INTERVIEWED THE BENEFICIARIES OF THIS DRIVE NAMELY, GEETA, RAMVATI AND SHANTI DEVI, AND ASKED THEM ABOUT THEIR LIVING CONDITIONS AND WHATEVER IT IS THAT WE CAN DO TO HELP THEM. THEY DISCUSSED WITH US THE HARDSHIPS THEY FACED DUE TO THE LOCKDOWN AND HOW ADVERSELY IT AFFECTED THEIR LIVES.











BEST TO PRESERVE OUR SURROUNDINGS.






ABOUT SPEAKER - AARUSH






ON 21/01/2023, HAMARI PAHCHAN STARTED CONDUCTING A SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME FOR CHILDREN AT ARJUN CAMP, MAHIPALPUR BY HELPING THEM RECOGNIZE THEIR CREATIVE SKILLS.

THE CHILDREN WERE FIRSTLY GIVEN A BRIEF DESCRIPTION ABOUT THE ART TO INTRODUCE ONESELF WHICH NOT ONLY INCLUDED TO IMPART CONFIDENCE IN THEM BUT ALSO MAKE THEM UNDERSTAND WHAT ALL NEEDS TO BE INCLUDED IN AN INTRODUCTION. 


KNOW YOURSELF




THESE MEASURES INCLUDE CARPOOLING OR USING PUBLIC

CHILDREN LEARNED ABOUT THE IMPORTANCE OF PROPER DISPOSAL OF


HAZARDOUS WASTE AND HOW THEY CAN SAFELY DISPOSE OF HOUSEHOLD CHEMICALS.

THE WORKSHOP AIMED TO EDUCATE CHILDREN ON THE IMPORTANCE OF THESE THREE PRINCIPLES IN CREATING A SUSTAINABLE FUTURE AND TO PROMOTE THE IDEA OF CREATING REUSABLE ITEMS. CLASS STARTED WITH AN INTRODUCTION TO THE THREE RS AND THEIR SIGNIFICANCE IN OUR DAILY LIVES.

ARYAN EMPHASISED THAT BY REDUCING OUR CONSUMPTION, REUSING ITEMS, AND RECYCLING MATERIALS, WE CAN REDUCE OUR ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT AND HELP CREATE A CLEANER, MORE SUSTAINABLE PLANET. THE SECOND PART OF THE WORKSHOP FOCUSED ON CREATING REUSABLE ITEMS. ARYAN BROUGHT IN A RANGE OF MATERIALS, INCLUDING OLD CLOTHES, BOTTLES, AND PAPER, AND DEMONSTRATED HOW TO TURN THEM INTO REUSABLE BAGS, CONTAINERS, AND OTHER HOUSEHOLD ITEMS. 




CHILDREN WERE INCREDIBLY EXCITED TO LEARN ABOUT THE GEOGRAPHY OF THEIR COUNTRY, AND WE WERE THRILLED TO BE ABLE TO PROVIDE THEM WITH THIS EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITY.

THE CLASS WAS HELD AT BHANWAR SINGH CAMP, AND WE HAD 18-19 CHILDREN IN ATTENDANCE. WE BEGAN BY INTRODUCING OURSELVES AND ASKING THE CHILDREN IF THEY HAD ANY PRIOR KNOWLEDGE OF INDIA'S MAP. SOME OF THEM HAD A BASIC UNDERSTANDING, BUT MANY WERE EAGER TO LEARN MORE.WE STARTED WITH A BRIEF HISTORY OF INDIA'S MAP AND HOW IT HAS EVOLVED OVER TIME.

WE ALSO TALKED ABOUT THE DIFFERENT STATES AND TERRITORIES OF INDIA AND THEIR RESPECTIVE CAPITALS. TO MAKE THE LEARNING EXPERIENCE MORE INTERACTIVE, WE PROVIDED THE CHILDREN WITH PRINTED MAPS AND ASKED THEM TO LOCATE DIFFERENT STATES AND CITIES ON THE MAP. THE CHILDREN WERE HIGHLY ENGAGED THROUGHOUT THE CLASS, AND IT WAS HEARTENING TO SEE THEIR ENTHUSIASM FOR LEARNING. THEY ASKED NUMEROUS QUESTIONS AND SHARED THEIR OWN EXPERIENCES OF TRAVELING WITHIN INDIA. WE ALSO SHARED SOME INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT THE COUNTRY'S LANDMARKS AND NATURAL WONDERS, WHICH SPARKED THEIR CURIOSITY EVEN MORE.



ON APRIL 15, ONE OF OUR INTERNS ORGANISED A WORKSHOP FOR UNDERPRIVILEGED CHILDREN ON THE TOPIC OF PHILOSOPHY. THE EVENT TOOK PLACE AT BHANWAR SINGH CAMP. THE WORKSHOP WAS AIMED AT INTRODUCING CHILDREN TO THE CONCEPT OF PHILOSOPHY AND ITS IMPORTANCE IN OUR DAILY LIVES. THE INTERN STARTED THE SESSION BY EXPLAINING WHAT PHILOSOPHY IS AND HOW IT CAN BE USED TO THINK CRITICALLY ABOUT THE WORLD AROUND US. THEY THEN PROCEEDED TO DISCUSS VARIOUS PHILOSOPHICAL CONCEPTS SUCH AS ETHICS, MORALITY, AND METAPHYSICS.

THE INTERN ENGAGED THE CHILDREN IN INTERACTIVE ACTIVITIES SUCH AS GROUP DISCUSSIONS AND ROLE-PLAYS TO HELP THEM UNDERSTAND THESE COMPLEX CONCEPTS IN A MORE FUN AND INTERACTIVE MANNER. THE CHILDREN WERE ENCOURAGED TO ASK QUESTIONS AND SHARE THEIR OWN THOUGHTS AND OPINIONS, WHICH LED TO LIVELY AND STIMULATING CONVERSATIONS. THE EVENT WAS WELL RECEIVED BY THE CHILDREN, WHO FOUND THE WORKSHOP ENGAGING AND THOUGHT-PROVOKING. MANY OF THEM EXPRESSED THEIR INTEREST IN LEARNING MORE ABOUT PHILOSOPHY AND ITS APPLICATIONS IN THEIR DAILY LIVES.






SEGREGATION FOR

UNDERPRIVILEGED CHILDREN IN BHANWAR SINGH CAMP. THE AIM OF THE WORKSHOP WAS TO EDUCATE THE CHILDREN ABOUT THE IMPORTANCE OF WASTE SEGREGATION AND ITS POSITIVE IMPACT ON THE ENVIRONMENT.

THE WORKSHOP STARTED WITH A PRESENTATION ON WASTE SEGREGATION, WHICH WAS DELIVERED BY OUR INTERN. THE PRESENTATION COVERED THE BASICS OF WASTE SEGREGATION. INCLUDING THE DIFFERENT TYPES OF WASTE AND HOW TO DISPOSE OF THEM PROPERLY. WE ALSO DISCUSSED THE BENEFITS OF WASTE SEGREGATION, SUCH AS REDUCING LANDFILL WASTE, CONSERVING RESOURCES, AND PREVENTING POLLUTION.

AFTER THE PRESENTATION, THE CHILDREN WERE DIVIDED INTO GROUPS AND GIVEN DIFFERENT TYPES OF WASTE TO SEGREGATE. THEY WERE ENTHUSIASTIC AND SHOWED A KEEN INTEREST IN LEARNING ABOUT WASTE SEGREGATION. OUR TEAM MEMBERS PROVIDED GUIDANCE AND ANSWERED THEIR QUESTIONS. THE CHILDREN WERE THEN ASKED TO PRESENT THEIR SEGREGATION TECHNIQUES AND EXPLAIN WHY THEY CHOSE TO SEGREGATE THE WASTE IN A PARTICULAR WAY THE WORKSHOP ENDED WITH A GROUP DISCUSSION ON HOW WASTE SEGREGATION COULD BE IMPLEMENTED IN THEIR DAILY LIVES. THE CHILDREN SHARED THEIR IDEAS AND PROMISED TO IMPLEMENT THEM IN THEIR HOMES AND







AFTER THE INTRODUCTION, THE CHILDREN WERE GIVEN COLOURING SHEETS WITH VARIOUS ENVIRONMENTAL THEMES, SUCH AS PLANTING TREES, RECYCLING, AND CONSERVING WATER. THEY WERE ENCOURAGED TO USE THEIR IMAGINATION AND CREATE THEIR OWN UNIQUE DESIGNS.

WHILE THE CHILDREN WERE BUSY COLOURING, THE INTERN SPOKE TO THEM ABOUT THE IMPORTANCE OF REDUCING, REUSING, AND RECYCLING, AND HOW THEY COULD INCORPORATE THESE PRACTICES INTO THEIR DAILY LIVES. THE INTERN ALSO DEMONSTRATED HOW TO MAKE A BIRD FEEDER USING RECYCLED MATERIALS, WHICH THE CHILDREN FOUND FASCINATING. IN ADDITION TO COLOURING AND CRAFTING, THE CHILDREN WERE ALSO TAUGHT A FUN SONG ABOUT THE ENVIRONMENT, WHICH THEY ENJOYED SINGING ALONG TO. THE INTERN ALSO GAVE OUT SMALL PRIZES TO THE CHILDREN WHO DEMONSTRATED THE MOST ENTHUSIASM AND CREATIVITY DURING THE ACTIVITIES.





ON APRIL 22 2023, A WOMEN EMPOWERMENT WORKSHOP WAS HELD AT THE BHANWAR SINGH CAMP IN A LOW-INCOME NEIGHBOURHOOD IN.

THE WORKSHOP WAS ORGANISED BY ONE OF OUR INTERNS, WOMEN FOR CHANGE, WHOSE MISSION IS TO EMPOWER UNDERPRIVILEGED WOMEN THROUGH EDUCATION AND SKILL-BUILDING. THE WORKSHOP WAS SPECIFICALLY DESIGNED FOR WOMEN WHO FACE FINANCIAL CHALLENGES, LACK OF EDUCATION, AND LIMITED ACCESS TO RESOURCES. THE WORKSHOP WAS FREE OF COST AND PROVIDED AN OPPORTUNITY FOR WOMEN TO LEARN NEW SKILLS, NETWORK WITH OTHER WOMEN, AND GAIN KNOWLEDGE AND CONFIDENCE. THE ATTENDEES WERE THEN DIVIDED INTO SMALL GROUPS AND ATTENDED VARIOUS SESSIONS LED BY EXPERTS IN DIFFERENT FIELDS. THE SESSIONS COVERED TOPICS SUCH AS FINANCIAL LITERACY, ENTREPRENEURSHIP, AND SELF-CARE.



THE EXPERTS SHARED PRACTICAL TIPS AND STRATEGIES THAT
THE ATTENDEES COULD APPLY IN THEIR DAILY LIVES.IN
ADDITION TO THE EDUCATIONAL SESSIONS, THE WORKSHOP
ALSO INCLUDED INTERACTIVE ACTIVITIES THAT HELPED THE
ATTENDEES BUILD CONFIDENCE AND COMMUNICATION SKILLS.
ONE SUCH ACTIVITY WAS A ROLE-PLAYING EXERCISE WHERE THE
ATTENDEES HAD TO NEGOTIATE A SALARY WITH A POTENTIAL
EMPLOYER.THE WORKSHOP ENDED WITH A PANEL DISCUSSION
FEATURING SUCCESSFUL WOMEN FROM THE COMMUNITY WHO
SHARED THEIR EXPERIENCES AND ANSWERED QUESTIONS FROM
THE ATTENDEES. THE PANELLISTS EMPHASISED THE IMPORTANCE
OF PERSEVERANCE, NETWORKING, AND SELF-BELIEF IN
ACHIEVING SUCCESS.
